- Purchasing cloud based College Management Software for Remote Accessing.
- Use digital mode of payment instead of cash payment.
- Online admission process may be started.

- All notifications issued by the Exam Cell are filed and kept in order. Relevant notifications are to be made available on the website with a printout kept in the file. Remittance of all fees could be made online.
- Time-tables for all the examinations are uploaded in the college website prior to one month of the examination date.
