Our College is situated in Mowad and Mowad is situated on the bank of the river 'Wardha' in Nagpur District. In the year 1991 river Wardha which was life giver of Mowad became life taker. She took a horrible form on 30th July in 1991. There was a huge deluge in Wardha River and it carried away the whole village. It was a Black Day in the history of Mowad. Nearly 207 people lost their lives. There were no bounds to the sufferings of people. It was rehabilitated in 1993. Even today they have not come out of that shock. In such adverse conditions, that time with great effort of the former Maharashtra Govt. Minister 'Shri Nitinji Gadkari' our management Nagar Parishad started the senior college, Nagar Parishad Mahavidyalaya.

Our College is run by Nagar Parishad Mowad (Municipal Council Mowad) which also runs convent, Primary School, Middle School, High school, Junior & Senior College. Nagar Parishad Shivaji Mahavidyalaya was established in 1996 and started its working in Nagar Parishad High school Premises in 1997. After that Hon'ble former Minister of Govt. of India 'Shri Subhodhji Mohite' donated money from Khasdar Fund for the construction of the college building. Our college is permanently affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur and recognized under 2(f) and 12(B) of UGC Act 1956 and accredited with "A" Grade CGPA 3.08 by NAAC Bangalore in CYCLE 3 in the year 2023. 3. Students coming from other universities will not be admitted unless the migration certificate is attached with the admission form.
4. Students will have to pay all outstanding college fees while submitting the exam application form.
5. Children of parents whose income is more than Rs. 2,50,000/-. Any change or amendment in tuition fee will be notified.

Norms for Admission

Admission process

a) First Year Bachelor of Arts (B. A. Part 1):

- At the time of admission in the first year, the students will be selected based on their academic merit and direct interview; admission will be given as per the merit list.
- Preference will be given to students with special merit in cultural, arts, literature or sports)

b) Second Year Bachelor of Arts (B. A. Part 2)

- For admission to B. A. Part-II it is mandatory to pass both semesters I & II of Part-1 or to pass at least 5 subjects of semester one and two.

c) Third Year Bachelor of Arts (B.A. Part 3)

- For admission to B. A. Part-III must pass both semesters of Part-1 and minimum 5 subjects in 3rd and 4th semesters of 2nd year are mandatory.

Necessary note regarding admission:-

- 1) After passing the 12th Higher Secondary Examination, Enrolment Form must be filled along with the admission form if one wants to take regular admission in the college. Fees will be charged for the same as per university rules.
- 2) As per the rules, students who have passed out of the college must mention their Enrolment number in the admission form if they want to take admission in the upper class.
- 3) Students who have passed from other universities other than RTM Nagpur University, if they want to get admission in this college, they must fill and submit the Nagpur University Enrolment Form along with the admission form. It is also necessary to attach the migration certificate and eligibility certificate of the concerned university. Otherwise admission will not be considered.
- 4) Students from other universities will not get admission to B. A. Part II & III under ATKT rule.

Note:

- All admissions to B. A. First Semester is carried out strictly on merit basis and as per the directives by the Government of Maharashtra and RTM Nagpur University, Nagpur.
- All admissions against open and other categories will be carried out as per the notified schedules. However the college reserves the right to effect necessary changes in the schedule if required.
- Students have to fill the prescribed application form available at the office for admission in his / her own handwriting. Students should not use any unnumbered or photocopied form.
- Information furnished in the admission form must be true. Admission is liable to be canceled if any information is found to be false or incorrect.

Rules & Regulations

Rules and Regulations:

1. Read the prospectus carefully for proper information.
2. The last date of submission of application forms will be displayed on the notice board as well as the website of the college.
3. The selected candidates will have to pay all fees within the prescribed date. In case a student does not deposit fees by that date, his/her admission is treated as canceled.
4. Students who cancel admission at any time for any reason shall have to pay tuition fees & other fees for the whole session.
5. No certificate of any kind will be issued unless full session fees are paid. Any amount paid by the student at the time of admission and later will not be refunded.
6. All new entrants will have to enroll themselves in the university. A prescribed Enrolment form for this purpose will be supplied by the college in due course of time and the date prescribed by the university. Students who fail to fill in the form shall be responsible for any action taken by appropriate authorities.

7. Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. They will be answerable to him for their behavior in general, both inside and outside the college. 8. Students should behave respectfully with all staff members at college and politely with their fellow students, including girls. Any act of improper and discourteous exchange of words or indecent remarks especially at girl students is a punishable offense and will be viewed seriously.
9. Students should make careful use of college books, room furniture, fans, computers and college property in general. The cost of damage done to be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
10. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom. Students, therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.
11. The students should not roam in corridors, or play during working hours or free classes; instead, they should utilize the library and reading room facility.
12. Identity Card should be carried at all times.
13. Smoking, Gutka/Pan chewing and ragging are strictly prohibited. Offenders are liable to face legal action. A committee exists to prevent this evidence.
14. Students are prohibited from forming associations/organizations and from holding functions in the college without the prior permission of the Principal.
15. Any change of address must be notified to the college office immediately.
16. For details of the curriculum refer to the syllabi of the University available on university portal as well as college website.
17. The students carry the responsibility of maintaining cleanliness on the campus. Dust bins have been provided at suitable places for this purpose, found littering the college premises or spitting on the wall or causing any dirtiness will be severely penalized.
18. Use/Possession of cell phone (mobile) in the college campus is strictly prohibited for students as per law.

19. The Principal's decision in all matters relating to admission, administration and enforcement of discipline and general rules and special instruction mentioned in this prospectus shall be final & binding on all.
